Job Duties:

Instructs and supervises Multi handicapped Blind or Visually impaired students in regularly scheduled classes. Planning curriculum, lessons and/or teaching methods using best practices in the field .Develops lesson plans to address those needs to include individualized instruction & training. Assess physical and perceptual motor needs of students in order to develop goals and objectives, and implement instructional lesson for appropriate student. Responsible for supervising children, teacher aides and Student Teachers as assigned. Assesses student progress by determining the extent to which individual student's learning goals were met; keeping records on academic performance and attendance; conducting tests (Standardized and State Proficiency) in accordance with OSSB policy and State law as requested; Making referrals for special services on an as-needed basis; Communicating with parents or guardians about student learning; Participating as a member of the IEP team (developing goals collecting academic information, participating as a team member during the conference, and document IEP progress);Conducting parent-teacher conferences on an as needed basis.

Minimum Qualifications:

Must maintain valid Ohio certification and/or licensure in Education of the Handicapped (K-12) and willing to Earn an Visually Handicapped (K-12) Licensure.

Conditions for Employment: Employment is contingent upon successful completion of criminal background check. The final applicant for this position will be required to submit to urinalysis prior to appointment to test for illegal drug use. An applicant with a positive test result will not be offered employment.
