Job Duties: Installs, maintains, configures, upgrades and/or administers hardware and/or software independently in workstation support, network administration, server administration, business continuity, information security, telecommunications and network connectivity, and SAN administration (i.e., multiple technology domains) where technical work requires specific knowledge to evaluate, select, adapt & modify standard procedures; devises new approaches to problems encountered. Diagnoses, analyzes and resolves issues for customer(s) across assigned multiple technology domains. Creates, organizes, files and maintains documentation. Reviews and monitors enterprise security systems; takes appropriate action and responds to alarms/alerts per agency policy and procedure (e.g., anti-virus, spam) Interfaces with other platforms from a hardware and/or software perspective

Minimum Qualifications

Completion of undergraduate core program coursework in information technology, electrical engineering or Telecommunications; 5 yrs. exp. in information systems analysis, design & operations; 18 mos. exp. in project/program Management; 2 courses or 6 mos. exp. in budgeting.

Agency Specific Minimum Qualifications:

Core associate program in Computer Science or Information Systems or equivalent work experience. and experience minimum 18 months combined work experience in any combination of the following: installing, Monitoring/maintaining, configuring, upgrading, and/or administering/operating a single technology domain as specified by the agency position description and vacancy/job posting. May be required to work evening or weekend hours.

Agency preferred: Must have the ability to learn at the intermittent level within 2 years.

Conditions for Employment: Employment is contingent upon successful completion of criminal background check. The final applicant for this position will be required to submit to urinalysis prior to appointment to test for illegal drug use. An applicant with a positive test result will not be offered employment. Unless otherwise instructed, submit a separate application or resume for each job opportunity posting in which you are interested. You must demonstrate on your application how you meet the minimum qualifications for this position.
