**Job Duties:** Serves as an unclassified employee pursuant to Section 3301.13 R.C. and performs the following educational and/or research duties: Provides technical assistance and educational research information to teachers throughout Ohio by: Conducting on-site visitations at request of LEA; Providing research-based teacher education and assistance regarding strategies that are effective with deaf/hard-of-hearing students; Conducting student observation and participation in IEP planning and review meetings as requested; Referring teachers and/or parents for additional resources and/or collaboration of agencies; Loaning materials/resources to teachers; Disseminating information packets to parents and teachers; Responding to e-mail, phone/mail inquires for assistance. Assesses need areas and maintains pertinent data on services by: Maintaining information on students/LEAs served, including demographic characteristics; Assessing needs periodically to ascertain satisfaction level for services and unmet need areas; Developing monthly and yearly summary reports. Increases public awareness of OSD services, needs of deaf students, and opportunities for collaboration (e.g., IVDL) by: Creating a visual display of OSD/Outreach services; Presenting at various colleges, SERRCs, community agency meetings; Participating in FLW planning; Designing and disseminating printed materials; Assisting parents in assessing needed services/options.

**Based on education/experience:** Ohio Driver's License; Intermediate level signing skills on the SLPI or equivalent; Valid Ohio Licensure/Certification as a teacher of the deaf K-12, or intervention specialist hearing impaired pre-K-12, or Licensed Speech Language Pathologist with a background in Deaf Education; Minimum of 5 years of teaching or experience working with students who are deaf or hard of hearing at various grade levels. May be required to work evenings and weekend hours.

**Conditions for Employment:** Employment contingent upon successful completion of criminal background check. The final applicant for this position will be required to submit to urinalysis prior to appointment to test for illegal drug use. An applicant with a positive test result will not be offered employment.
