Job Duties: Provides auditory, speech, and language therapy to students by: instructing student(s) in auditory training, speech development and language development using various methods (e.g., diagnostic and achievement tools); preparing instructional material and case notes (i.e., individual or group, according to needs). Provides auditory, speech and language services to students/clientele by: evaluating IEP progress and completing records in accordance with IEP guidelines; participating in IEP and staffing sessions; assisting the MFE team and other evaluation services. Develops a well structured educational environment by: maintaining order in the classroom and, in conjunction with administrative staff, discipline when necessary to achieve proper behavior. Maintains communication and records by: submitting monthly billing for Medicaid; contacting parents and/or local school district regarding student progress; keeping notes and recording student progress in case notes and progress reports.

Position Specific Minimum Qualifications:

Must maintain valid Ohio teaching certification and/or licensure in the education of the hearing handicapped. Must demonstrate advanced level of ASL (SCPI rating). Demonstrate the ability to communicate effectively with students, parents, and other staff members by using American Sign Language; Written English; Electronic Communication Systems.

Conditions for Employment: Employment contingent upon successful completion of criminal background check (BCI/FBI). The final applicant for this position will be required to submit to urinalysis prior to appointment to test for illegal drug use. An applicant with a positive test result will not be offered employment. New hires will be required to have directed deposit.
