Job Duties: Identifies student's service requirements by conducting psychological evaluations and/or assessments; administering, scoring and interpreting psychological tests and/or assessments; reviewing pre-admission or pre-treatment information from local schools. Assists administrators in student's personal and social development by conducting interviews and writing evaluation reports for school aged students with emotional or behavior problems; reviewing and evaluating behavior plans; providing psychological intervention treatment; serving as advisor on psychological matters (e.g., IEP, MFE, etc.); participating, facilitating and documenting the treatment review team process; conducting student counseling and following up on treatment. Protects student's confidentiality and school operations by maintaining and monitoring confidential information process; reporting suspected abuse or maltreatment to law enforcement authorities and superintendent. Resolves student problems and needs by being available for students on a 24-hour basis; utilizing agreed upon multidiscipline team strategies.

Minimum Qualifications:

Must possess a school psychology certificate and meet Ohio State Board of Psychology requirements.

Must have a valid Ohio driver's license. May be required to work evenings. Demonstrate the ability to communicate effectively with students, parents, and other staff members by using Written English, Braille, and/or Electronic Communication Systems.

Conditions for Employment:

Employment is contingent upon successful completion of criminal background check. The final applicant for this position will be required to submit to urinalysis prior to appointment to test for illegal drug use. An applicant with a positive test result will not be offered employment. Unless otherwise instructed, submit a separate application or resume for each job opportunity posting in which you are interested. Enter the classification and position control number (pcn) of the position for which you are applying at the top of the front page of the application. You must demonstrate on your application how you meet the minimum qualifications for this position. Failure to do so will result in your application being screened out and you will not be granted an interview for this position.
