#### **Job Duties:**

Instructs and supervises visually impaired students assigned in regularly scheduled classes. Monitors and assesses student performance by use of a variety of methods including diagnostic and achievement instruments (e.g., verbal and/or written tests and/or homework). Prepares individualized daily lesson plans for students enrolled in classes; prepares instructional materials; maintains classroom/educational supplies and equipment; prepares curriculum; maintains records on individual student progress and attendance; subs for other teachers as required. Supervises teacher aides (e.g., monitors performance) & student teachers (e.g., helps in development of lesson plans; monitors instruction and supervision; offers direction). Participates in annual development of the student's individual educational plan. Serves as homeroom teacher, students advocate and class sponsor (e.g., keeps attendance records). Participates in and/or conducts as requested by supervisor, inservice programs (e.g., keeps other staff members updated on the progress of orientation and mobility students). Supervisors field trips and other out-of-class experience (e.g., assembly programs). Attends to other duties as determined by principal (e.g., conducts tours of school; attends staff meetings; serves on committees).

#### **Minimum Qualifications:**

Ohio Driver's License; O&M certification or O&M and TVI certification.

#### **Conditions of Employment:**

Employment is contingent upon successful completion of criminal background check. The final applicant for this position will be required to submit to urinalysis prior to appointment to test for illegal drug use. An applicant with a positive test result will not be offered employment. Unless otherwise instructed, submit a separate application or resume for each job opportunity posting in which you are interested. Enter the classification and position control number (pcn) of the position for which you are applying at the top of the front page of the application. You must demonstrate on your application how you meet the minimum qualifications for this position. Failure to do so will result in your application being screened out and you will not be granted an interview for this position.
