**Job Duties:** Provides Vision-related services to families or school district programs or area providers by: providing information on visual impairments and early development; conducting developmental assessments for children with functional vision, orientation and mobility needs, using best practice methods; providing suggestions to parents and teachers for environmental adaptation for children that may be used at home and at preschool facilities; advocating for school districts and parents making their educational programs accessible to visually impaired students; identifying visually impaired resources and area providers; suggesting ideas for motivational toys, learning materials, and early literacy experience; creating and compiling information packets for preschool providers. Provides local school staff in-service training on visually impaired related topics by: scheduling and working with school districts and/or parents in establishing training programs that are readily available and appropriate; developing training programs that are adaptable and can be used at the local school for parents and staff; Assists OSSB in carrying out their mission by: participating in faculty meetings, school committees, educational conferences/courses, extra curricular activities and/or professional training days; participating in other student related programs (e.g., annual development of student IEP goals, intervention teams, educational clinic etc. as needed.)

### **Minimum Qualifications:**

Must maintain valid Ohio certification/licensure: Visually Handicapped (K-12); and Early childhood experience. Have a willingness to take additional coursework in Orientation and Mobility training.

### **Preferred Qualifications:**

Demonstrate the ability to communicate effectively with students, parents, and other staff members by using:

- Written English;
- Electronic Communication Systems.
- Braille

**Conditions for Employment:** Employment is contingent upon successful completion of criminal background check. The final applicant for this position will be required to submit to urinalysis prior to appointment to test for illegal drug use. An applicant with a positive test result will not be offered employment.
