Job Duties:

Instructs, follow lesson plans, and assesses student knowledge on behalf of the permanent teacher by incorporating specified lesson plans, using a variety of techniques, including lectures, projects, exhibits, library resources, computers, and the Internet; monitoring, assisting, correcting, and grading student performances; engaging students in meaningful and authentic instruction, remediation and assessment activities. Maintains a well structured educational environment by maintaining order in the classroom and, in conjunction with administrative staff, discipline when necessary to achieve proper behavior; reporting to administrator unusual behavior issues. Monitors students when needed by keeping records of academic performance, attendance, and social acclimation; reporting on all aspects of student development for school records and parents; sharing, with other teachers, and staff, responsibility for monitoring halls, study periods, and lunchroom; reporting cases of suspected child abuse to administrator and/or law enforcement authorities according to state law. Maintains professional licensure and development by upgrading personal/professional knowledge and skills pursuant to State of Ohio teaching licensure requirements. Performs other duties as assigned by assisting with transition, IEPs and etc.; conducting standardized tests.

Minimum Qualifications:

Must maintain valid Ohio certification and/or licensure in the education of the blind and visually impaired.

Conditions for Employment: Employment is contingent upon successful completion of criminal background check. The final applicant for this position will be required to submit to urinalysis prior to appointment to test for illegal drug use. An applicant with a positive test result will not be offered employment. Unless otherwise instructed, submit a separate application or resume for each job opportunity posting in which you are interested. Enter the classification and position control number (pcn) of the position for which you are applying at the top of the front page of the application. You must demonstrate on your application how you meet the minimum qualifications for this position. Failure to do so will result in your application being screened out and you will not be granted an interview for this position.
