Job Duties: Instructs students in a well disciplined, managed, and creative classroom by Performing work associated with standards based student instruction; developing learning goals/lesson plans that are appropriate for students and are aligned with the school's curriculum or state standards; by writing vocational/career goals and objectives for student IEP's; adopting instruction material, developing input for and presents daily instructional/learning activities based upon the Individualized Education Plan (IEP); evaluating students academic and behavior progress; providing standardized vocational situational assessments for students; teaching desirable work studies, i.e., career exploration, self-determination, or other career/vocational education curriculum; assisting in providing job coaching to students as needed; developing employment sites and provide on-site support and follow-up for students who are placed in work experience sites; maintaining a positive classroom environment, utilizing appropriate classroom management, keeping students on task, and engaging students to learn. conducting tests (Standardized and State Proficiency) in accordance with OSB policy and state law as requested; completing vocational assessments on identified students; preparing reports on assessments; communicating assessment information to school personnel, parents, and transition department; coordinating students' career portfolios. Provides career assessment information to foster student program development by: developing assessment tools for students with unique learning; determining the extent to which individual student's learning goals were met; create and maintain student records and repair reports relevant to the work progress of students (e.g., report cards, IEP Progress Reports).

Minimum Qualifications:

Must maintain valid Ohio ODE certification in Visually Handicapped (K-12)

Conditions of Employment:

Employment is contingent upon successful completion of criminal background check. The final applicant for this position will be required to submit to urinalysis prior to appointment to test for illegal drug use. An applicant with a positive test result will not be offered employment. Unless otherwise instructed, submit a separate application or resume for each job opportunity posting in which you are interested.
