

OLBPD Kids and Teens Reading Club

The Ohio Library for the Blind and Physically Disabled also known as “OLBPD” would like to invite students to join our exclusive reading club for kids and teens. Students who are registered to receive braille and talking books, magazines, or download items using BARD are eligible to join this free club as part of their library service with OLBPD.

When students sign up, they will receive an official membership certificate and an id badge. When members read books they will earn credits toward leveling up to new membership levels. They can reach higher membership levels based on the number of books they read at their reading level. Here are the levels they can earn:

Bronze level:	25 books
Silver level :	100 books
Gold level :	300 books
Platinum level:	500 books

Members will earn rewards as they achieve new levels. Our goal is simple: we want to make reading fun at any age but especially now! If students are 11 years old and younger they can join the OLBPD Kids Reading Club. If students are between the ages of 12 and 18, they can join the OLBPD Teens Reading Club. ALL kids club members will graduate to the teens reading club when THEY turn 12 years old. Plus, all of the books that you read will transfer over with you.
